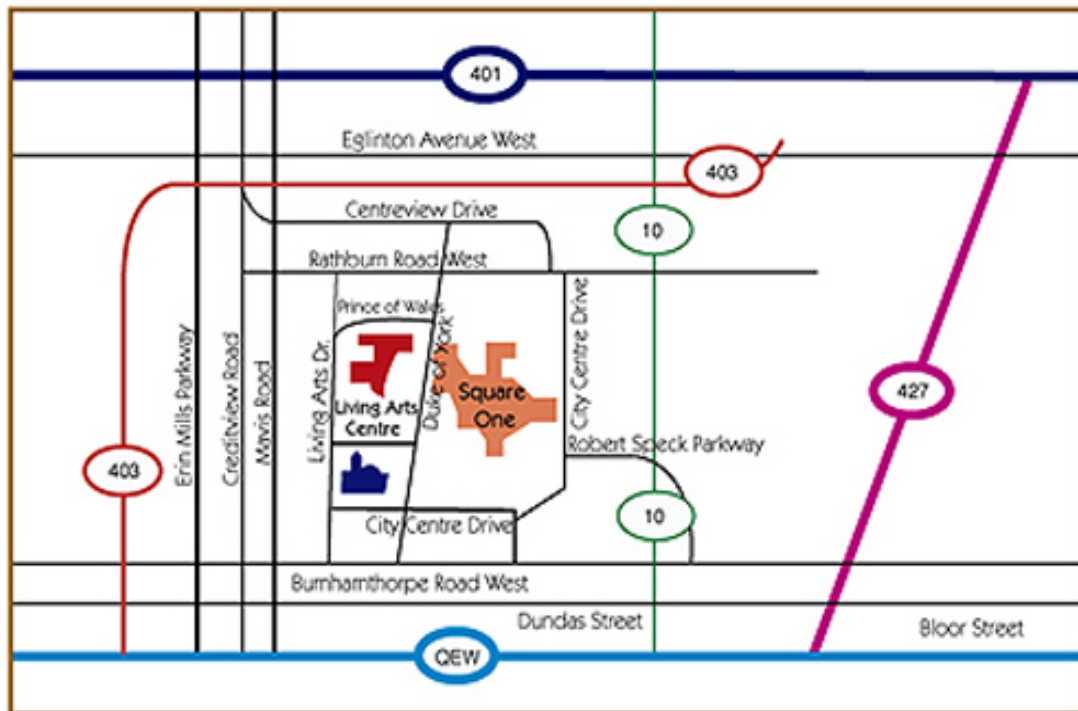

### **From Toronto:**

QEW west to Hwy 10 (Hurontario St.). North on Hurontario Street to Burnhamthorpe Road. West on Burnhamthorpe Road to Living Arts Drive. North on Living Arts Drive.

Or:

Hwy 401 west to Hwy 10 (Hurontario St). South on Hurontario to Burnhamthorpe Road. West on Burnhamthorpe Road. North on Living Arts Drive.

### **From Hamilton:**

QEW east to Hwy 10 (Hurontario St.) North on Hurontario Street to Burnhamthorpe Road. West on Burnhamthorpe Road to Living Arts Drive. North on Living Arts Drive.

Or:

QEW east to Hwy 403. East on Hwy 403 to Centrevue/Mavis exit. Take Centrevue exit to Duke of York. South on Duke of York to Rathburn Road. West on Rathburn Road to Living Arts Drive. South on Living Arts Drive.
